### Introduction

The information provided here are for those individuals who were born into this family tree in England. This is a fairly thin record as many people are missing and documentation for the ones that are here is lacking. Services that allow access to some of these documents are not free. I reluctantly admit that the risk of errors may be high; however, I make every effort to document and research everyone listed here as best I can.

Information on a majority of the HAMOND individuals come from three sources, (1) Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON, (2) Neal<sup>1491</sup> Owen HAMMON, and (3) Freda PODMORE. Information on the majority of the non-HAMOND individuals come from Rodney<sup>256</sup> Reo HAMMONS.

Individuals in bold and italics with a "+" in front of their names indicates there is more information about the individual and their families (if found) further on down the document. I use Family Tree Maker as my genealogical database. When a person is added to that database he or she is assigned a unique number by the program. The number you find next to a person's first name is the assigned number. Correspondences concerning individuals should be accompanied with their unique number. An email address is provided at the end of the Introduction.

The spelling of the last name appears in the Norfolk County record during this time as HAMOND and HAM'OND. There is another family tree in Suffolk County, just south of Norfolk, that historically have spelled their surname as HAMMOND, which is the most common spelling used then and today; they are of no relation. It isn't until some family members migrate to the London area that we see a change, most often as HAMMOND; however, the original spelling of HAMOND is used as well. I can only assume that record keepers during this time assumed the spelling was universal and that spelling was HAMMOND. If someone could not read or write then they were at the mercy of the recorder. There is some evidence that by the mid-1600's that at least two other spellings appeared, HAMON and HAMMON. The other spellings in this family, HAMONS, HAMONDS, HAMMONDS, and HAMMONS did not appear until after the family immigrated to America.

Most amateur researchers enter a birth date for these individuals when in fact they are entering their baptismal or christening dates. While some babies may have been baptized the day they were born most were not. Baptism could come days, weeks, or even months later and therefore should not be used as a birth date unless documents state the birth and baptism occurred on the same day. The other mistake often made is the use of baptism and christening as though they were the same thing. Christening is when a child is given a Christian name. Many times they do happen at the same time, but christening could come later, but never before

baptism. Documents for baptism and christening are much easier to find than that of the actual birth, unless they all occur on the same day and recorded as such.

For those new to genealogy, there is a practice rarely if ever seen today ... the reuse of a child's name within the same family. This usually occurs when a child dies at birth or at a very young age. The practice of naming another child the same was not uncommon. Another, but less common reuse, was if children were born in a 2<sup>nd</sup> marriage. This was most often seen when a man named one of his sons after himself, then his spouse died and he remarried, and then he named one of their sons after himself again.

#### A final word of caution:

While HAMOND is not a common name, its highest concentration (probably in the world) was in the London area during this timeframe. New Testament Christian first names were very common, even into modern times. It was common for several 1<sup>st</sup> cousins to all have the same first name, making it nearly impossible, if not impossible, to separate individuals whose first name is John, Mary, Elizabeth, or Thomas, for example. Other common HAMOND family names included Robert, Edmond, Margaret, and Ann. These names are also found among other non-related HAMOND families. One feels a little more comfortable with uncommon family names such as Ambrose, Nicholas, and Francis. While not exclusive to this family, they were not common and made determining which family they belong to much easier. While doing your own research be aware that the Mary HAMOND you find might not be the Mary HAMOND you are looking for.

## England 1500-1700

The most distant known paternal ancestor of this particular HAMOND¹ line currently is John¹ HAMOND², who was probably born between 1490 and 1500 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. He died and left a will in 1546, also in Scarning, where he was buried³ on December 1, 1546. He married Katherine, whose maiden name is currently unknown, probably within a year of their first born child in about 1521. Katherine, along with their children, are listed in John's will where she, along with son Robert, are identified as co-executors. Robert is the 4<sup>th</sup> son of John and Katherine and why he was chosen over his 3 older brothers will probably never be known.

The genealogical journey that led to the discovery of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND began with Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON in the 1930's as he began to trace his paternal roots. His efforts eventually led him to the immigrant ancestor, Ambrose<sup>83</sup> HAMMON, who was transported to America in the mid 1660's. Many people erroneously show Ambrose as having come to the Virginia Colony on March 26, 1666; however, this date is the land patent<sup>4</sup> date for land given to Robert TALIAFRO and Lawrence SMITH for transporting 126 individuals from England to America, including Ambrose. They were given 6,300 acres on the Rappahannock River in Virginia. In the patent, Ambrose's surname is spelled HAMON. It was obvious at this point that the next logical step was to search in England. Stratton then hired a professional genealogist, Freda PODMORE, to work the English connections.

What Fred PODMORE discovered in London, England was a baptismal entry for "Ambrose, son of John Ham'ond and Mary, 28 Feb. 1647, in St. James Parish, Clerkenwell". I have found no explanation for the hyphenated spelling. At the time of this baptism. Clerkenwell was a village outside of London proper, but is now located in central London. It must also be noted that John<sup>75</sup> HAMOND also immigrated to America and that date is currently unknown, but most likely occurred within "a year or so" of Ambrose's immigration. John appears to have been a seafaring man as his name disappears from English records for long periods of time and then reappears. In information I received from my aunt I found this: "John Hammon was transported by Captain Thomas Wood on the ship, *Hopewell*, from London to Virginia via Barbados on February 17, 1634. It is believed that he was an agent for London businessmen because of his traveling back-and-forth from America to England." Stratton<sup>1244</sup> also has this information in his notes, also without documentation. Since both have the same information without knowledge of each other there must be some documented evidence for this information. My aunt cannot remember where she got this information and I have yet to rediscover it myself, so it remains uncertain if this is the same John. John's last entry in England is when he marries his 2<sup>nd</sup> wife.

Dorothy<sup>89</sup> LATHAM, on June 22, 1669 in London. Dorothy is always shown as being born in Old Rappahannock County, Virginia Colony in about 1648. I have found no corroborating evidence to support this. If this is true, the possibility exists John had met Dorothy on one of his crossings, but then taking her back to England where they marry is difficult to grasp.

Freda PODMORE's research in 1953 shows that this paternal lineage resided in the London for at least 3 generations. When she realizes the next step goes back to Norfolk County, England before their migration to London, she decides to end her search efforts. With her stoppage, Stratton<sup>1244</sup> decides to make contact with officials in Norwich, Norfolk, England in September of 1953 and goes to Norfolk himself and continue the search. He made visits in 1954, 1961, and 1971 where he made contact with Captain Anthony HAMOND, a distant relative that neither Stratton<sup>1244</sup> nor his son Neal<sup>1491</sup> makes mention. It would have been nice to know from which branch Anthony HAMOND descended. It has been apparent that Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON and Neal<sup>1491</sup> Owen HAMMON's research focused strictly on their branch. Very little if any information is known about the distant aunts and uncles from England.

When the family migrated from Norfolk to London is not known, but with the marriage of John<sup>75</sup> HAMOND's parents, Francis<sup>74</sup> HAMOND and Elizabeth<sup>435</sup> TAYLOR in London in 1608, it would obviously be no later than that date. Francis would have been 18 years of age at the time of his marriage and since there is no indication that his father, Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND, ever resided in London, Francis would have come with other unknown family members or on his own as a young man. The date range for this migration would probably be between 1605 and 1608.

With the last known birth of this lineage in Scarning, Norfolk, England in 1609 (Edmund<sup>72</sup> HAMOND), this paternal branch lived in Scarning for at least 100 years before going to London. There is a will left in Scarning for a Nicholas HAMOND who was born in 1450 that could be John¹ HAMOND's father or grandfather. It is unknown if this particular HAMOND family tree is the only one that resided in Norfolk, especially in the Scarning and Wendling area, or if other non-related HAMOND families were also in the area. Scarning was and still is a small village, so the possibility that Nicholas HAMOND belongs to this paternal lineage is very high. There is a HAMOND family tree in Suffolk County (southern border of Norfolk County) that many have confused with the Scarning, Norfolk HAMOND's tree. This confusion probably stems from the fact that there is a John HAMMOND who was born in about the same time as John¹ HAMOND. Most documents indicate that the Suffolk County group spells the surname as HAMMOND while the Norfolk County groups spells the surname as HAMMOND.

John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND and their Descendants of England.

Generation 1

John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND was probably born between 1490 and 1500 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. This HAMOND family tree lived in the Scarning and Wendling area for at least 100 years before some members of the family moved to the London area. Wendling is less than 2 miles to the northwest of Scarning. Both are currently small villages and probably were no bigger during the 1500's.



County Norfolk is the historical home of Queen Boudica and the Iceni Tribe of Celts, who fought the Romans in an attempt to keep Britain free. The Romans ruled the area until about 400 AD when they abandoned the land to several Germanic tribes. Norfolk then became the home of the invading Angles. Their tribal name is the root for the modern name England. The area of Norfolk is still referred to as East Anglia today.

John married Katherine<sup>2</sup> in about 1521 and she is suspected of being born in about 1505. These dates are based off the few known date facts that we have about John and his children. They include John's will date, burial date, and the marriage dates of Robert, Margaret, and Marion. Where Katherine was born is unknown and when and where she died is also unknown. We do know she was alive at the time of John's death in 1546 for she is co-executor of his will with their son Robert. Best guess is that she was also born and died in the Scarning area.

John's will was written in Middle English script and difficult to decipher. We do not currently have a word-for-word translation of the will, but do have an abridged version provided by Glynn Burrows.

John Hamonde of Scarning, Yeoman, made his will on 11th of November 1542. At that time he was in good health and mind. He went through the usual religious text for a will and then went on to the will proper. His wife was Katherine and he left her the household goods, his milking herd ("milche neate"), harness and a bay colt. He left his son Robert a bed among other things. (A bed was one of the most prized possessions as they were expensive items and often it would be "the bed as it stands" which means with all the hangings, mattress, pillows, etc.) He mentions pasture land which was leased from Mr. Robert XXXXX Esquire. (This name eludes me at present!). He also mentions Shappell Meadow with the little meadow lying within the hedge. He left 20 bullocks to Robert and a grey mare. 20 bullocks to son Edmund, 10 bullocks to son Nicholas, 5 bullocks to daughter Margaret, and 5 bullocks to daughter Marion. These bullocks were to be pastured till Michaelmass or such time as they were sold and those owning them would pay their share of the rent. Then he mentions his eldest son, John who gets the white mare, a cart and harness and collars. His eldest daughter was Elizabeth and she got one white bullock. Robert Hamonde the younger got a brown bullock. Alice Hamonde got a black one. The proceeds from corn and other household earnings was to go towards keeping the house for a year and was to be until the Festival of Saint Margaret the Archangel (Michaelmass). His final bequest is to his servant, Margaret Collen and he gives her 12d (one shilling). He made his wife and son Robert his executors.

A yeoman, in English history, was a class intermediate between the gentry and the laborers; a yeoman was usually a landholder, though it should be pointed out that there were two types of landholders during this time. One was the type we usually associate with landholders today, someone who owns the land outright. The other was someone who we associate with a land lease. In this case the 'landholder' typically leased the land for 99 years. The wording in John's will indicates that he probably the later.

The known children of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND are:

### Generation 2

### John<sup>4</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, son

John<sup>4</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1521 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in about 1560, probably in Floedon, Norfolk, England. Floedon is probably a misspelling or mistranslation of Flordon, which is a small village about 10 miles south of Norwich. For the location of Norwich in Norfolk see Figure 2. A translation of his father's will indicates he is the eldest son and received a white mare, a cart and harness, and collars. We have no further information on John except for the possibility of two children. There are two grandchildren listed in his father's will, Robert the Younger and Alice. Most of John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND's grandchildren were born after his death and the one individual whose children would probably have been born before that death would have been John<sup>4</sup> HAMOND's children. Currently they are assigned to him without proof. He is the son of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

The probable children of John<sup>4</sup> HAMOND and his unknown wife are:

Robert<sup>485</sup> HAMOND (b: c1540, d: unk). He is probably the individual listed as Robert the Younger in John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND's will who receives a brown bullock. Nothing more is known about Robert.

Alice<sup>35918</sup> HAMOND (b: c1542, d: unk). She is probably the individual listed in John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND's will who receives a black bullock. Nothing more is known about Alice.

### Edmund<sup>5</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, son

Edmund<sup>5</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1522 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in about 1584, possibly in Trowse, Norfolk, England at the age of about 62. He made his will in 1582 and it was proven in 1584. He appears to have spent some time in Flordon with his brother John<sup>4</sup> and is also mentioned in Trowse where he left his will. Trowse is a small village about 1½ miles south of Norwich. He received 20 bullocks according to his father's will. Currently it is unknown who his spouse was, but he does have a daughter, Maria<sup>10</sup>, who was baptized in Wendling, Norfolk, England. The fact that Maria<sup>10</sup> was baptized in 1580 in Wendling could be his last ties to the area as all other information concerning Edmund is closer to the Norwich area. He is the son of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

The known child of Edmund<sup>5</sup> HAMOND and his unknown wife is:

### Maria<sup>10</sup> HAMOND

• She was baptized<sup>5</sup> on December 15, 1580 in Wendling, Norfolk, England. She is also listed as being born in the same year

### William<sup>6</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, son

**William** <sup>6</sup> **HAMOND** was born in about 1523 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and when he died is unknown. He is not mentioned in his father's will which probably means he had died prior to the writing of John<sup>1</sup>'s will in 1542. This could also mean that William is not the son of John<sup>1</sup>, though researcher Anthony HAMOND believes it is so. He is the son of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

### Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, son

Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1524 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1606 in Wendling, Norfolk, England at the age of about 82. He married Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON on July 10, 1547 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. Robert, along with his mother, was executor of his father's will and in some documents is identified as 'Robert the Executor'. In his father's will he receives 'the bed as it stands', 20 bullocks, and a grey mare. He is the son of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

Some facts concerning Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND:

- 1546: Executor of his father's will.
- 1558/9: Listed as one of the jury in the Scarning Hall Manor Rolls.
- 1582/3: Identified as 'of Wendling' when his son Henry was admitted to Caius College (part of Cambridge).

Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON (aka Anna) was born in about 1528 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1606 in Wendling, Norfolk, England and was buried there on June 26, 1606. She is entered as "Anna Hamond, rid. relica Robert Hamond" with a marginal note stating, "Soror fil Thom Penton filia Jo. Penton sen." The entry is repeated in Wendling as "Anna Hamond, vid: buried 29 June 1606." She is the daughter of John<sup>16</sup> PENTON and Elizabeth<sup>36727</sup> Jane HENELY.

The known children of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON are:

## Elizabeth<sup>45137</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, daughter

Virtually nothing is known about Elizabeth<sup>45137</sup> HAMOND except she is listed in her father's will as the eldest daughter and she is given one white bullock. She was probably born in Scarning, Norfolk, England sometime after the birth of Robert<sup>3</sup> in about 1524 and before the birth of Margaret<sup>8</sup> in about 1539. She is the daughter of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

## Nicholas<sup>6</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, son

Nicholas<sup>6</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1533 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1600 in Wendling, Norfolk, England and was buried<sup>6</sup> there on April 13, 1600 at the age of about 67. He married Margaret (maiden name unknown). She was buried<sup>7</sup> on December 25, 1590 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. Nicholas<sup>6</sup> is mentioned in his father's will as receiving 10 bullocks. He is the son of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

### Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, daughter

Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1539 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in October of 1612 in Wendling, Norfolk, England at the age of about 73. She married<sup>8</sup> Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE on October 1, 1559 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. She is listed in her father's will and receives 5 bullocks. She is the daughter of John<sup>1</sup> and Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND.

Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE I was born in about 1535 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died on April 6, 1591 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England at the age of about 56. Shipdham is about 4 miles south of Scarning.

The known children of Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE and Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND are:

- He was baptized on October 10, 1560 in Carbrooke, Norfolk, England. When
  he died is unknown. Carbrooke is 19 miles due south of Scarning and only 10
  miles due south of Shipdham.

## Marion<sup>9</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, daughter

Marion<sup>9</sup> HAMOND (aka Maria) was born in about 1542 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. When she died is currently unknown. She is listed in her father's will and receives 5 bullocks. She married Thomas<sup>14</sup> PENTON on May 25, 1562 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. Thomas<sup>14</sup> was born in about 1540. The relationship between Thomas<sup>14</sup> and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON (Marion's sister-in-law) is currently unknown. The likelihood they are related is very high.

The known child of Thomas<sup>14</sup> PENTON and Marion<sup>9</sup> HAMOND is:

### Generation 2

## Katherine<sup>17</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, granddaughter

Katherine<sup>17</sup> HAMOND was born in 1548 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. When she died is currently unknown. She was baptized on August 7, 1548 and christened on August 17, 1548 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. She appears to be named after her grandmother Katherine<sup>2</sup> HAMOND. She married<sup>10</sup> Walter<sup>18</sup> ELIE on October 18, 1569 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. Walter made his will in 1601 and filed it with the Archdeaconry of Norwich. His surname has also been spelled ELY. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON. I have yet to find any children.

# Francis<sup>19</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

Francis<sup>19</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1550 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1583 also in Scarning at the age of about 33. He was buried in Scarning on April 4, 1583 and left no will. He was baptized in Scarning on March 30, 1550. He married Elizabeth<sup>20</sup> TAYLOR on July 17, 1580 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. Francis is the first known use of the name that will be handed down for several generations. He is the son of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

Elizabeth<sup>20</sup> TAYLOR was born in about 1554 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1625, probably in Scarning, at the age of about 71. She was buried in Scarning on August 12, 1625. She is the daughter of Robert TAYLOR and Margaret GRAYE.

The known children of Francis<sup>19</sup> HAMOND and Elizabeth<sup>20</sup> TAYLOR are:

### Robert<sup>486</sup> HAMOND

• He was baptized on March 18, 1580 in Wendling, Norfolk, England. When he died is currently unknown.

John<sup>487</sup> HAMOND (b: c1582, d: unk)

Mary<sup>488</sup> HAMOND

1. She was baptized<sup>11</sup> on May 19, 1583 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. When she died is currently unknown.

Robert<sup>486</sup> is listed as being born in Wendling while John<sup>487</sup> and Mary<sup>488</sup> were born in Scarning.

### Leonard<sup>22</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

Leonard<sup>22</sup> HAMOND was born on January 15, 1552 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. This birth date is most likely his baptismal date. He died in 1644 in Scarning at the age of about 91. The age seems out of tune for the time, but still is possible. Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON has done extensive research on his branch of the HAMOND tree and he states that Leonard<sup>22</sup> as a child of Robert<sup>3</sup> and Agnes<sup>15</sup> is possible. He makes no mention as to why he is not 100% convinced. Being a HAMOND and living and dying in the Scarning-Wendling area strongly suggests all these individuals were related. It is therefore possible that Leonard<sup>22</sup> could be the son of any of Robert's brothers. Pending further discoveries he will remain as the son of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

## John<sup>24</sup> HAMOND

### Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

John<sup>24</sup> HAMOND was born in 1555 and baptized on March 27, 1555 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and died in 1620 in Wendling, Norfolk, England where he was buried on May 14, 1620. He left a will with the Archdeaconry of Norwich dated May 11, 1620. His will was proved on June 17, 1620. He married<sup>12</sup> Martha<sup>25</sup> BRETT on February 24, 1599 at Weasenham All Saints, Norfolk, England. He mentions in his will that he has two sisters still living, but I have not found a copy to determine which sisters they are. I do not have the death dates for any of his 4 sisters. He is the son of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON. Since no children are listed in his will he and Martha either did not have any children or any that were still alive at the time of his death.

### Anne<sup>26</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, granddaughter

Anne<sup>26</sup> HAMOND was born on March 19, 1559 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. When she died is currently unknown. She was baptized in Scarning on January 10, 1560 and christened there on March 29, 1560. Anne is a perfect example of why one should not assume that baptism and christening occur on the same date. While no death date has been found thus far information states she was buried at 'Catton', which is believe to be a misspelling of Cotton, which is in Suffolk County, England. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

### Susanna<sup>27</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John¹ HAMOND, granddaughter

Susanna<sup>27</sup> HAMOND was born in 1561 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. When she died is currently unknown, but she is shown as being buried in Pentney, Norfolk, England, which is about 20 miles due east of Scarning. She was baptized<sup>13</sup> in Scarning on May 25, 1561. Neither Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON nor Anthony HAMOND list her as a child of Robert<sup>3</sup> and Agnes<sup>15</sup>. Did they miss her in their research? for she is not found in any of their data. Her baptismal record shows her as a child of Robert HAMOND. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

### Henry<sup>28</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

Henry<sup>28</sup> HAMOND was born in 1564 in Scarning, Norfolk, England and baptized there on April 30, 1564. He died in Cambridge, Cambridgeshire, England in 1616 and was buried<sup>14</sup> there at St. Michael on October 13, 1616 a the age of 52. The entry spells the name as HAMMOND. He was interred as a 'Fellow of Caius'. He was

admitted to Caius College at Cambridge in 1582. He may very well have been the first HAMOND to ever attend college. He is the son of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

The following was provided by Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON:

Translating freely from the History of Gonville and Caius College, given in Latin, apparently Henry was a person of some violence for on 12 Dec 1608 he was fined the considerable sum of one pound "because he laid violent hands upon Master Jermy and Doctor Smyth and treated them very badly, with taunting words, and because he reviled one Duisborough, then University Proctor and furthermore refused to sheath the sword he was brandishing, lashing him with bitter words which he refused to withdraw."

## Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II was born in about 1566 in Scarning, Norfolk, England, where he was baptized<sup>15</sup> on September 8, 1566, and died between January 30, 1651 and May 20, 1652 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England at the age of about 85. Kirby Bedon is a hamlet about 3½ miles southeast of Norwich. His baptismal entry reads "filius 4 et ultimus existus Roberti Hamond per Agnetam res: su: 8 September anno a partu virgineo 1566."

The following was provided by Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON:

Judging by his children's baptisms, he appears to have spent the first ten years or so of his married life at Kirby-Bedon and returned to Scarning about 1599; an illness prior to death in 1600 of his father-in-law Robert Sheppard would account for this. He was apparently living at Scarning in 1631 or thereabouts. On admission to Caius College in 1619/20 of his son Nicholas, he was described as "husbandman."

He married (1) Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD on November 11, 1589 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England and after her death in 1611 he then marries<sup>16</sup> (2) Ann<sup>33</sup> Starling on September 22, 1629. They had no issue. He is the son of Robert<sup>3</sup> HAMOND and Agnes<sup>15</sup> PENTON.

Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD (aka Margery) was born in 1564 in Norfolk, England, probably in the Kirby Bedon area where she was baptized on March 8, 1566. She was christened there 10 days later on March 18, 1566. She died on May 9, 1611 in Norfolk, England at the age of 47. She was 25 years of age when she married

Robert<sup>29</sup>, which is unusual for a time in which most women were married in their midteens. There is a marriage entry for a Margaret SHEPPARD to a Robert POYSTER in 1585 which could account for her later marriage to Robert<sup>29</sup>. If this is her then one can only assume Robert POYSTER must have died prior to her marriage to Robert<sup>29</sup>. She was 1 of 11 children of Robert<sup>31</sup> SHEPPARD and Anne<sup>32</sup> UNDERWOOD.

The known children of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD are:

- He was baptized on May 7, 1609 in Scarning, Norfolk, England.
- When she died is currently unknown. Some researchers show the date as 1620, but Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON states she was alive in 1620 without reference.

# Robert<sup>35922</sup> CRASKE II Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, grandson

Robert<sup>35922</sup> CRASKE is listed as being born on January 4, 1561 in Scarning, Norfolk, England, but this is most likely his baptismal date<sup>17</sup>, and died in March of 1644 in Wendling, Norfolk, England at the age of 83. He was buried on March 23, 1644, presumably in Wendling. He married Alice<sup>45221</sup> POTTER on June 29, 1587 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England. He is the son of Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE and Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND. Nothing more is known about Alice.

### Dorothy<sup>35921</sup> CRASKE Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, granddaughter

Dorothy<sup>35921</sup> CRASKE was born in about 1570 in Scarning, Norfolk, England where she was baptized on September 10, 1570. She died and was buried on March 16, 1654, possibly in Shipdham, Norfolk, England. Shipdham is about 11 miles south of Scarning. She married William<sup>45141</sup> Johannes FLAGG I on March 27, 1594 in

Shipdham, Norfolk, England. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE and Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND.

William<sup>45141</sup> Johannes FLAGG I was born in about 1572 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on February 12, 1572. He died and was buried on January 31, 1657 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England at the age of about 85. He is the son of William FLEGGE and Joane SKARLETT.

The FLAGG surname is also spelled FLEGG and FLEGGE.

The known children of William 45141 Johannes FLAGG and Dorothy 35921 CRASKE are:

Richard<sup>35919</sup> CRASKE was born in about 1572 in Scarning, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on March 1, 1572 and died in March of 1645 in Wendling, Norfolk, England at the age of about 72. He was buried<sup>18</sup> on March 23, 1644 in Wendling. He married Ann<sup>37648</sup> BARNES on June 11, 1598 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England. He is the son of Robert<sup>13</sup> CRASKE and Margaret<sup>8</sup> HAMOND.

Ann<sup>37648</sup> BARNES died in April of 1639 in Wendling, Norfolk, England. When she was born is currently unknown. Based on her marriage date she would probably have been born between 1578-1583.

The known child of Richard 35919 CRASKE and Ann 37648 BARNES is:

He is the son of Thomas<sup>14</sup> PENTON and Marion<sup>9</sup> HAMOND.

# Francis <sup>74</sup> HAMOND I Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great grandson

Francis<sup>74</sup> HAMOND I was born in 1590 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on August 16, 1590 and died on May 20, 1652 in London, England at the age of about 62. He also appears to have been buried the same day in London. His name is found "Among the horsemen equipped by George GAWSELL and mustered at Swaffham in 1639 to go upon the King's Service in the North." Anthony HAMOND also states "Francis HAMOND who, with Robert HAMOND, John HAMOND and three people from the Scarning area, are shown as serving under the Earl of Northumberland in 1640 by the Muster taken after the Army's retreat from Newcastle into Yorkshire." He drew up and witnessed the will of Leonard HAMOND of Scarning, possibly Leonard<sup>22</sup> HAMOND his uncle. Who he married is currently unknown. He is the son of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

There are many people who list his wife as Elizabeth TAYLOR. His uncle Francis<sup>19</sup> HAMOND, who he is possibly named after, married Elizabeth<sup>20</sup> TAYLOR. I don't know what the odds are of both Francis's marrying an Elizabeth TAYLOR, but since they also show them having died in the same year I believe they are confusing the two Francis HAMOND's. Francis<sup>19</sup> HAMOND and Elizabeth<sup>20</sup> TAYLOR's marriage is documented, but I have not found any documentation for who Francis<sup>74</sup> HAMOND married.

The exact time Francis<sup>74</sup> moved from Scarning to London is not known, but he had to have been in London at least at the time of the birth of his son John<sup>75</sup> HAMOND I who was born there in about 1610. He would have been about 18 years of age at the time and what prompted the move may never be known.

The known children of Francis<sup>74</sup> HAMOND and his unknown wife are:

Ann<sup>48</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1592 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England where she was baptized on August 20, 1592. When she died is currently unknown. She married Francis<sup>49</sup> ROBINSON I on July 12, 1627 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

Francis<sup>49</sup> ROBINSON I was born in about 1588 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England. When he died is currently unknown. He is the son of Rev. Hugh ROBINSON and Ann CORY.

The known children of Francis<sup>49</sup> ROBINSON I and Ann<sup>48</sup> HAMOND are:

Hamond<sup>53</sup> ROBINSON (b: c1615, d: unk). Nothing more is known about Hamond. John<sup>52</sup> ROBINSON (b: c1617, d: unk). Nothing more is known about John. Francis<sup>54</sup> ROBINSON II (b: c1619, d: unk). Nothing more is known about Francis.

# Robert <sup>55</sup> HAMOND III Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great grandson

Robert<sup>55</sup> HAMOND III was born in about 1594 in Scarning, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on November 10, 1594. He died on August 15, 1678, but I have not found where, but most likely in the London area. He married (1) Ann<sup>62</sup> STINT on March 22, 1624 in Southwark, Surrey, England, (2) Dorothy<sup>489</sup> (maiden name unknown) in about 1638, and (3) Amy<sup>491</sup> MARKANT in about 1675. He is the son of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

He is also called 'Robert of Intwood' and 'Robert of Dalwhaite'. Intwood is a village about 5½ miles south-southwest of Norwich and Dalwhaite is a part of Scarning. He inherited lands in Fransham and Beeston in 1620 under the will of his uncle John<sup>24</sup> HAMOND. Fransham is a civil parish just east of Scarning. There are three villages in Norfolk with the name Beeston, but it is most likely the one closest to Scarning and Fransham. According to Stratton<sup>1244</sup> Owen HAMMON, "he seems to have been the Stewart of the Manor of Wendling Abbey (Thomas HAMOND, Esq. Lord) from 1646 or earlier until 1666, yet in 1655 he did not appear in person before the Scarning Manor Court to seek admission to hold lands of his late father and late brother Francis but was represented by his brother Henry acting as his attorney."

The suspected children of Robert<sup>55</sup> HAMOND III and Ann<sup>62</sup> STINT are:

Elizabeth<sup>56</sup> HAMOND – Nothing more is known about Elizabeth. Ann<sup>57</sup> HAMOND – Nothing more is known about Ann. Agatha<sup>58</sup> HAMOND

- When she was born is currently unknown.
- She died<sup>20</sup> and was buried on December 9, 1629 in Scarning, Norfolk, England.

The suspected children of Robert<sup>55</sup> HAMOND III and Dorothy<sup>489</sup> are:

Ann<sup>490</sup> HAMOND — Nothing more is known about Ann. Alice<sup>60</sup> HAMOND — Nothing more is known about Alice.

The suspected child of Robert<sup>55</sup> HAMOND III and Amy<sup>491</sup> MARKANT is:

Robert<sup>61</sup> HAMOND IV – Nothing more is known about Robert.

Note: I have considerable reservations concerning all of these children. They all have come to me without documentation of any kind. I feel best about the children of Ann<sup>62</sup>. The biggest concern is with Amy<sup>491</sup> MARKANT. If her birth year estimate of 1650 is correct, then I suggest she is the wife of Robert<sup>61</sup> HAMOND IV and not his mother, and therefore Robert's mother is unknown.

## Ambrose<sup>63</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great grandson

Ambrose<sup>63</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1597 in Kirby Bedon, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on August 7, 1597. When he died is currently unknown. He married Ann<sup>64</sup> REEVE on September 30, 1629 at St George Martyr in Southwark, Surrey, England. Southwark was south across the River Thames from old London and is now within the city itself. Nothing is known about Ann. He is the son of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

Ambrose<sup>63</sup> HAMOND is the first person in the HAMOND family tree to receive this first name. His cousin Ambrose<sup>11839</sup> SHEPPARD was born a few months prior. Ambrose<sup>11839</sup> SHEPPARD appears to have been named after his mother's half-brother Ambrose FYSKE. This first name is then used by Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD in naming her son. What is significant is the fact that Ambrose is used by someone in the HAMOND family, generation after generation, for over 200 years!

## Henry<sup>65</sup> HAMOND I Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great grandson

Henry<sup>65</sup> HAMOND I was born in about 1599 in Scarning, Norfolk, England where he was baptized on February 27, 1599. He died on February 10, 1657 in Scarning,

Norfolk, England. He married Katheren<sup>66</sup> COLE on August 15, 1615 in Southwark, Surrey, England. If his baptismal year is also the year he was born then Henry<sup>65</sup> would have been about 16½ years of age when he married. When Katheren<sup>66</sup> was born is unknown. If she was the same age as Henry<sup>65</sup> then she would have been born in about 1600. She could have been a few years older; that would not be uncommon. He is the son of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

Henry<sup>65</sup> appeared in 1655 at the Scarning Manor Court as the attorney for his brother Robert<sup>55</sup> HAMOND III.

The known child of Henry<sup>65</sup> HAMOND I and Katheren<sup>66</sup> COLE is:

Henry<sup>73</sup> HAMOND II (b: c1617, d: unk). Nothing more is known about Henry.

# Elizabeth<sup>67</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great granddaughter

Elizabeth<sup>67</sup> HAMOND was born on March 23, 1602 in Scarning, Norfolk, England. She was baptized there 5 days later on March 28. She married Henry<sup>68</sup> HART on September 20, 1638 in Southwark, Surrey, England. When she died is currently unknown, but the couple immigrated<sup>21</sup> to Jamestown, Virginia Colony in 1637 and it is assumed she died there. There appears to be some issue between the marriage and arrival dates. Based on other known historical records the marriage year is probably wrong. She is the daughter of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

Henry<sup>68</sup> HART first married Rebecca<sup>3072</sup>. When she was born is currently unknown. I have seen it listed as early as 1595 and as late as 1602. On August 31, 1635 Henry<sup>68</sup> was patented 350 acres of land for her, and 5 others, transportation to Virginia Colony and she died soon after their arrival. Some list her maiden name as SPENCER, though I have found no proof of this. He returns to England soon afterwards where he marries Elizabeth<sup>67</sup>. He returns to Virginia Colony with Elizabeth<sup>67</sup> in 1637 and is patented 250 acres in James City on the Surry side for the transportation of Elizabeth<sup>67</sup> and four other persons. This land was also adjacent to the land of Thomas ROLFE, son of John and Pocahontas. (The ROLFE land was later purchased by Thomas WARREN, who married the widow of Henry HART's son, Thomas)<sup>22</sup>. In *Adventurers of Purse and Person*, John Frederick DORMAN contends that the mother of Thomas HART was the second wife, Elizabeth.

The known child of Henry<sup>68</sup> HART and Elizabeth<sup>67</sup> HAMOND is:

## Nicholas<sup>69</sup> HAMOND Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great grandson

Nicholas<sup>69</sup> HAMOND was born in about 1604 in Scarning, Norfolk, England were he was baptized on November 18, 1604. When he died is currently unknown. He was admitted to Caius in 1619 at the age of 15. He appears to be the 2<sup>nd</sup> known HAMOND to attend college. He married Sara<sup>70</sup> AYRE on March 30, 1635 at St George Martyr in Southwark, Surrey, England. Nothing more is currently known about Sara. He is the son of Robert<sup>29</sup> HAMOND II and Margaret<sup>30</sup> SHEPPARD.

# Sarah<sup>45146</sup> FLAGG Relationship to John<sup>1</sup> HAMOND, great granddaughter

Sarah<sup>45146</sup> FLAGG was born on June 5, 1595 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England and died in 1630, also in Shipdham at the age of 34. She married Peter<sup>45155</sup> VINCENT on October 10, 1619 at All Saints Church in Shipdham, Norfolk, England. She is the daughter of William<sup>45141</sup> Johannes FLAGG and Dorothy<sup>35921</sup> CRASKE.

Peter<sup>45155</sup> VINCENT (aka Petris) was born on March 28, 1591 in Shipdham, Norfolk, England and died on September 27, 1650 at the age of 59 years, 5 months, and 30 days. He was buried the next day at All Saints Church in Shipdham. He was previously married to Elizabeth TREWBODY. He is the son of Thome VINCENT and Agnetis HODSON.

The known children of Peter<sup>45155</sup> VINCENT and Sarah<sup>45146</sup> FLAGG are:

We know that Francis Hamond of London, probably his brother, was listed as "mariner & gunner." The death of this Francis in 1667 cut another tie and was possibly an added reason for John to marry and take his new wife to Virginia in 1669 to join his son Ambrose who had left three years sooner. The exact year that John and his new wife left for Virginia is unknown, but the newlyweds disappear immediately from the English records and then later appear in Virginia."

There are several mentions of John HAM(M)OND individuals in and out of Virginia Colony in the early to mid-1600's, but it is probably impossible to accurately determine if they are all the same person or many and if this John is among those found.
